



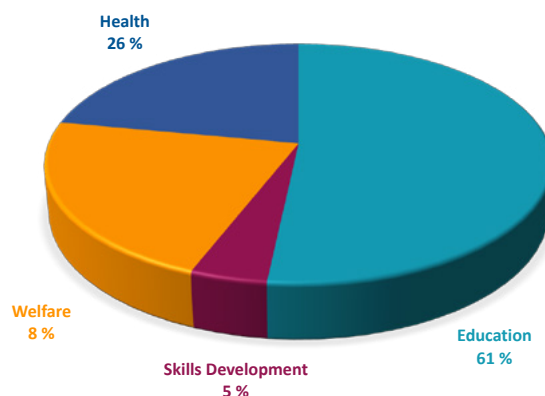
A SAFER, BRIGHTER HOME FOR CHILDREN IN ADELAIDE



We are proud to share the successful handover of upgrades at the Children's Home of Hope in Adelaide. This project has brought meaningful improvements to the home, including upgraded facilities and the addition of two new infrastructure components. Most importantly, the home now has reliable access to water and electricity, basic services that were previously unavailable. These changes have transformed daily life for the 13 children and their caregivers, creating a safer, more comfortable and dignified environment.

SUPPORTING LOCAL BUSINESSES THROUGH SITE VISITS

As part of our commitment to supporting local businesses, our Social Performance Team recently visited eight SMMEs across Adelaide, Bedford, Cookhouse and KwaNojoli.

These businesses operate in sectors such as catering, construction, waste management, electrification and education support. The visits followed a series of training workshops that helped business owners improve compliance, including company registration, tax, and BBBEE requirements.

The purpose of the visits was to better understand each business, its challenges, and growth opportunities. By engaging directly with entrepreneurs, we were able to have honest conversations about market access, finances and day-to-day operations.

These insights will help us provide more targeted support going forward, ensuring that local businesses are better equipped to grow, create jobs and contribute to the local economy.
