



## DONATION OF NEW MOBILE HEALTH CLINIC



A new mobile health clinic vehicle has been donated by the Cookhouse Wind Farm Community Trust to the Bedford and Adelaide communities. The mobile clinic, along with a ward-based outreach team, offers a range of services, including health education, medication administration, follow-ups, and referrals.

This donation forms part of our broader Primary Health Care Project in partnership with the Eastern Cape Department of Health, which was established seven years ago. The aim of the project is to provide free and accessible healthcare services to residents across 71 farms, addressing critical health needs in remote areas.

We're excited to highlight the success of the Columba Leadership Programme at Siphso Camagu and Johnson Nqonqoza High Schools.



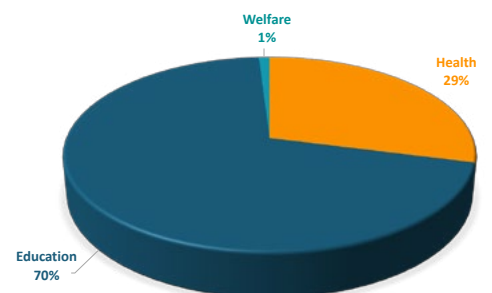
